Thank you for your support, these might not seem like a lot but you know the saying: "Every little bit helps!"

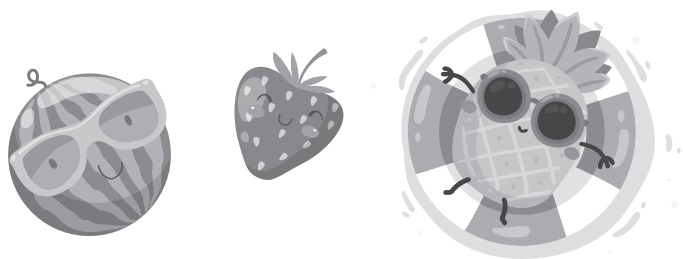

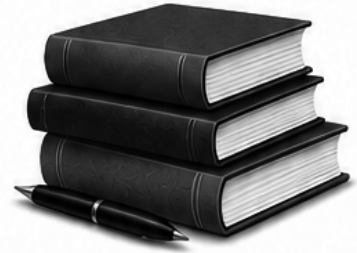

PELLMAN**
FICTION AUTHOR

- Author of 12 novels and novellas including the two-book set of the “Eden” political dramas, along with a collection of short stories.
- Prior to publishing his works, he served for 27 years as Director of the Shelby County Department of Job and Family Services. Terry is also a former member of the Sidney City Council including two years as Vice Mayor.
- His most recent release is the novel “There was a Buckeye Tree”. It is a fictional memoir of an elderly man who left his Shelby County home in the middle of the night in 1966 at age 16 and went on to become involved in the anti-war counterculture of the late 1960s and early 1970s.
- He is a past third place winner of the *Dayton Daily News* short story contest out of 600 entries.



**MIKE
VAN HORN**
FICTION AUTHOR

- A Sidney resident, Mike has authored four books.
- The first is a work of historical fiction titled *Neil Down*. It is the story of an assassination attempt on Neil Armstrong, the first man to walk on the moon, at the celebratory parade in Wapakoneta in 1969.
- The next three books are a series of thrillers set in the present day. The main characters are an Airman recently retired from Air Force Special Operations, and his wife. All three books, *Controlled Flight*, *The Fireteam*, and *The Ivy Leaguers*, are set in west central Ohio and contain elements of local history. All made it to the short list of books in the Clue Suspense & Thriller category of the Chanticleer International Book Awards, an annual contest that focuses on self-published books.
- *Controlled Flight* went on to the finalist level in the Chanticleer judging and was also entered in the Eric Hoffer Book Award contest, which examines self-published books as well as those from small publishing houses. It was chosen as one of four Grand Prize finalists in a field of several thousand entries.
